OCD Ireland, a non-profit organisation, is looking for **Two Support Group Facilitators** to facilitate our support groups. OCD Ireland has Dublin based support groups for Obsessive Compulsive Disorder (OCD), Body Dysmorphic Disorder (BDD), Trichotillomania (TTM or Trich) as well as a family and friends group. The groups meet in St. Patrick's University Hospital on either a Monday or a Tuesday evening. Further Details:

Training:

- All facilitators undergo an initial free OCD Ireland training and they are provided with further free training twice a year.
- All OCD Ireland facilitators are required to attend a two day ASIST training as well as a one day child protection training (fee paid by OCD Ireland).

Essential for Application:

- Have at least a Bachelors degree in Psychology
- Available either Monday and Tuesday evenings from 6:30 pm – 9 pm
- Prior experience in group facilitation

Desirable for Application:

- Prior experience with OCD, Body Dysmorphic Disorder and Trichotillomania
- An understanding of Aspergers Disorder as it often co exists with OCD spectrum disorders
- Previous training in group facilitation
- Recent attendance at child protection training
- Prior attendance at ASIST training
